CRITERIA:

- **Minimum GPA of 2.75**
- **Must be a senior who is interested in pursuing a career in Law Enforcement**
- **Must be attending a post-secondary school in Fall 2023**

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- **2 Letters of Recommendation must be submitted.**
- **List of extracurricular activities and notable honors & accomplishments.**
- **The Guidance Office will need to submit a transcript along with this application.**
- **Essay: 500 word typed essay**
 - **Topic: ‘Why I Would Like to Pursue a Career in Law Enforcement’**
- **Completed application along with essay and 2 letters of recommendation turned into the Guidance Office no later than Monday, April 3rd, 2023**

Officer Lloyd Earl Reed, Jr. served with the Seven Springs Borough Police Department, St. Clair Township Police Department, Hooversville Borough Police Department and Seward Borough Police Department for a combined total of 25 years. Officer Reed was shot and killed while responding to a domestic disturbance call at a home in New Florence, PA. At the suggestion of Chief Robert Malnofsky, the Southern Clarion Police Association has developed a scholarship program in honor of Officer Reed. The scholarship will be awarded to a deserving individual in our service area who is planning to further their education in law enforcement or the skilled trades. We believe that it is fitting to so honor an Officer who gave his life in service to the community. SCPA welcomes your contributions to this effort.
