- **Senior with at least a 2.75 GPA attending post-secondary school in the coming Fall pursuing a career in Law Enforcement.**

- **List of work history, community involvement, honors or accomplishments.**
- **Letter of intent (500 words or less) explaining why you chose the Police Academy or clearly explaining your career goals in law enforcement.**
- **Your future goals upon completion.**
- **Completed application with above list of documents turned into the Police Department at 220 Broad St., New Bethlehem, PA 16242 or mailed to P.O. Box 1, New Bethlehem, PA 16242 by March 16, 2026.**

Officer Lloyd Earl Reed, Jr. served with the Seven Springs Borough Police Department, St. Clair Township Police Department, Hooversville Borough Police Department and Seward Borough Police Department for a combined total of 25 years. Officer Reed was shot and killed while responding to a domestic disturbance call at a home in New Florence, PA. At the suggestion of Chief Robert Malnofsky, the Southern Clarion Police Association has developed a scholarship program in honor of Officer Reed. The scholarship will be awarded to a deserving individual in our service area who is planning to further their education and certifications in law enforcement. We believe that it is fitting to so honor an Officer who gave his life in service to the community. SCPA welcomes your contributions to this effort.
